INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for choosing a Freemount TV wall mount. Our products are distinguished by high quality, durability and modern design. The holder ensures a durable and safe fastening of the TV or LCD / LED monitor with parameters consistent with the parameters given on the package and in the installation instructions.

PLEASE READ THE USER MANUAL CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLING THE WALL MOUNT AND STARTING USE.

The most important conditions for proper and safe use of the equipment together with the wall mount are: the correct selection of the wall mount for the TV or monitor and the correct mounting of the wall mount on the wall and the attachment of the TV / monitor on the wall mount.

Before installing, please make sure that the model of the wall mount you have purchased fully matches the parameters of the TV for which you want to use the wall mount.

First of all, make sure that: - the weight of the TV does not exceed the maximum permissible load on the wall mount, - the diagonal of the TV screen falls within the range of diagonals recommended for the wall mount, - the spacing of the mounting holes located on the back wall of the TV (usually according to vesa standard) falls within the range of the spacing of the mounting holes of the wall mount.

IMPORTANT WARNINGS BEFORE INSTALLATION.

The structure of the wall must be such as to maintain a load corresponding to the load parameters given for the handle model and to the weight of the equipment mounted on the handle. If this condition is not met, the face must be reinforced to obtain the appropriate maximum load.

The installation of the wall mount and equipment must be carried out in accordance with the installation instructions of the wall mount and the instructions of the equipment manufacturer, provided that the equipment manufacturer gives instructions or recommendations for installation on the wall mounts.

The installation of the wall mount requires basic knowledge and skills in the installation of such devices and the use of basic tools enabling the making of appropriate holes in the wall, the placement of dowels with appropriate parameters for a given type of wall structure, and screwing the fixing screws and screwing the TV /monitor to the handle. In case of doubt or lack of suitable tools, we recommend that you contact a specialized assembly plant for this type of equipment.

Do not install on a structure that is subjected to vibrations, movements, shifts, or is exposed to impacts or any type of impact and shock. Failure to comply with this condition may result in damage or damage to equipment and walls, material damage and danger to the user.

Do not install on loose structures, on walls made of unknown material, on any surface whose load carrying capacity and rigidity is inspecified or in doubt. In such cases, you should consult a construction specialist, the administrator / owner of the building or the relevant building documentation.

Do not install in the vicinity of appliances that heat or operate with open flames, such as fireplaces, in places exposed to direct sunlight, or any factors causing strong heating or cooling, such as air conditioning systems, or causing high humidity. Failure to do so may damage or damage the TV, equipment and walls, material damage and danger to the user.

At least 2 qualified persons must be able to install the holder and the TV. The danger to the user or damage to the equipment may occur as a result of the fall of the TV receiver during installation.

The recommended mounting surfaces of the handle are smooth and uniform concrete walls, of bricks, walls of hardened wood composites or uniform hardwood, in the case of concrete and similar walls, provided that suitable pins and screws are used for a given type of substrate.

We do not recommend mounting on partitions made of plasterboard, chipboard and the like. If you need to mount the handle on this type of wall, you need to stock up on screws / fixing pins suitable for your wall type. If you have any doubts, consult a construction specialist to determine the strength of the wall, the appropriate screw attachment points and the use of appropriate pins/screws to secure the wall type.

In case of any doubts, you should consult a construction specialist. Incorrect mounting of the handle, use of incorrect screws or pins, selection of a wall with insufficient load carrying capacity, threatens danger.

Set of mounting elements of the wall mount:



The included set of screws and dowels is suitable for most wall types, but it does not have to be suitable for every type of wall. In case of doubt, you should stock up on a set of screws (and possibly dowels) suitable for the type of wall and maximum load, available in specialized construction stores.

TO INSTALL THE WALL MOUNT, YOU WILL NEED BASIC TOOLS:

Screwdriver, drill with drill suitable for wall type, spirit level (for handle model without built-in level indicator). For different types of wall surfaces, you should stock up on suitable screws or dowel fasteners for your type of walls, available in specialized construction stores.



Before mounting, select the correct place to attach the TV.

NOTE: Electrical, water, gas, etc. wiring must not run at the hole sites. Before choosing a mounting location, make sure or check with appropriate testers that there is no installation at the site of drilling the hole, there is no joining of the wall plates, there are no steel or other structural building elements. If you have any doubts, please consult the appropriate specialist or the administrator/owner of the building or read the relevant building documentation.

STEP 1 : INSTALLATION OF THE BASE ELEMENT (WALL FIXER).

CONCRETE WALLS, OF BRICKS, OR OF SIMILAR MATERIAL.

In the case of a wall of concrete, brick or similar material, dowels should be used.

In the wall, drill holes of suitable cross-section into the applied dowels and then insert (or slightly knock with a hammer, depending on the wall and fit into the hole) pins into the holes. Then attach the handle to the wall and screw it by screwing the screws into the pins. Do not drill holes at the place where the bricks are joined.

When using the attached dowels for brick/concrete walls: - hole depth approx. 50 mm, drill section: \emptyset 10 mm or \emptyset 8 mm depending on the dowels used.



INSTALLATION ORDER:

1. Place the wall mount against the wall at the location you selected earlier.

2. Using the built-in level indicator or secondary level, level the wall mount and mark the holes to be drilled on the wall.

3. Drill holes in the wall at the selected points, then insert (slightly knock) the dowels (I). Do not drill holes at the place where the bricks are joined.

4. Apply and screw the wall mount to the wall with screws (ST) after laying the washers (J).

5. Apply a plastic cover





After mounting the wall mount, the level indicator should be in the center, as shown in the figure.

WOODEN WALLS, OF CHIPBOARD, OF DRYWALL

In the case of partition walls of drywall, wood or chipboard, the screws fixing the wall mount must be screwed in place of the posts supporting the wall, provided that the posts are strong enough and can maintain the weight of the TV.

For this type of walls, dowels are not used (except for specialized dowels for drywall).



INSTALLATION ORDER:

1. Place the handle against the wall at the location you selected earlier.

2. Using the built-in level indicator or secondary level, level the wall mount and mark the holes to be drilled on the wall.

3. Drill holes in the wall at the selected points. (drill cross-section: \emptyset 5 mm or \emptyset 3 mm depending on the screws used)

- 4. Attach and screw the wall mount to the wall with screws (ST) after laying the washers (J).
- 5. Apply the plastic cover





After mounting the wall mount, the leveling indicator should be in the center, as shown in the figure.

NOTE: After screwing the wall mount, make sure that the screws are tightened properly, do not move, twist loosely, do not move in the wall, in the case of dowels make sure that they are firmly fixed in the wall and do not move.

The screw should be tightened until there is palpable, strong resistance. After tightening to the end of the length, the screw must not rotate loosely in the hole. In this case, the thread has been twisted or the section of the screw does not correspond to the cross-section of the hole, the screw does not fix the wall mount, the fixing is dangerous.

In this case, repeat the installation of the screw until a strong attachment is obtained.

STEP 2 : INSTALL THE SCREEN FASTENERS.

Place the TV (screen) on a soft and safe surface and screw the fasteners (rails) to the back of the TV case. Select screws that match your TV's openings and mounting areas using the included screws (A, B, C or D), washers (G) and spacers (H) if necessary.





FOR TVS WITH A CURVED BACK PANEL OR OTHER BUMPS ON THE CASE:

If the ends of the mounting rails do not exactly adhere to the surface of the rear of the TV case, use spacers (H) as shown in the picture.



The fastening elements (rails) must be fully tightened and adhere the entire surface to the rear casing of the TV receiver, must not move, move, be tilted, the attachment must ensure that the weight of the TV is maintained.

STEP 3 : ATTACH THE SCREEN TO THE BASE ELEMENT AND ADJUST IT.

With the help of the other person, lift the TV with screwed-on rails over the wall- attached element, place the TV and carefully lower it by attaching the tv's mounting rails to the rails fixing the wall element, as shown in the figure.





SETTING THE TV'S TILT ANGLE.



Loosen the clamping knobs that lock the tilt angle adjustment, then position the TV at the desired angle and tighten the terminal knobs to lock the TV in its position.

CABLE HOLDERS



The wall mount has hooks to hold the connection cables so that they do not hang from the TV. The cables must be led through the hooks on the shoulders of the wall holder. (Depending on the version, the tabs may be included separately in the wall mount kit.)

After mounting the wall mount with the TV on the wall, make sure that the wall mount firmly holds the TV firmly, the fixing on the screws does not shift, move, screws or fixing pins do not come out of the holes, they are not loosened.

After mounting on the wall, do not place additional load on the TV, do not hang additional objects on it that may cause the permissible load on the wall mount to be exceeded. Do not twist, tilt, pull away the suspended TV. To re-position the tilt, first loosen the adjustment screws, then set the tilt and tighten the screws again.

The included set of screws and pins does not have to be suitable for any type of wall. In case of doubt, you should stock up on a set of screws (and possibly dowels) suitable for the type of wall and maximum load, available in specialized construction stores.

NOTE: Electrical, water, gas, etc. wiring must not run at the hole sites. Before choosing a mounting location, make sure or check with appropriate testers that there is no installation at the site of drilling the hole, there is no joining of the wall plates, there are no steel or other structural building elements. Do not tighten with too much force so as not to twist the screws. Make sure that the screws are tightened properly, do not move, twist loosely, do not move in the wall, in the case of dowels make sure that they are firmly fixed in the wall and do not move.

Make sure both parts of the wall mount are properly and securely connected, there is no slack, the fixing screws have not loosen.

NOTE: IT IS NECESSARY TO CHECK REGULARLY THE CORRECTNESS OF THE FASTENING

The base attaching to the wall must not move, it must not deviate from the wall. The tv mount must not deviate from the back of the TV case.

If loosening of the wall mount is found, remove the TV from the holder, check and tighten the screws, and reassemble if necessary.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON USE AND INSTALLATION

Before installing, make sure that the handle and its details do not have defects (cracks, etc.). Installation and installation must be carried out in accordance with the description and recommendations given in the user's manual.

The product is intended for home use only, in temperate climatic conditions.

The product is intended for internal installation only and must not be suitable for outdoor use.

Do not expose the product to weather conditions, high temperatures, moisture, etc.

Do not expose the product to vibrations, shocks or other similar factors.

Never load the handle with a weight greater than the specified weight.

Never change, weaken and/or strengthen the handle structure.

The product is intended only for installation on walls made of solid material: e.g. stone, concrete, cement elements, hollow.

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Warranty

GENERAL WARRANTY CONDITIONS

- The warranty period is 5 years from the date of sale indicated on the proof of purchase. Defects or defects of the goods revealed during this period will be removed free of charge in accordance with the terms of the warranty. If you replace your equipment for a new warranty period, it will be re-dated from the date of replacement of the product by Emmerson Service.
- 2. The warranty is valid only in the territory of the country where the product was purchased.
